**What string programs will I offer to the students at St. Peter?** Violin, viola and cello  
Taking beginners through advanced, 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grades in all three instruments.

**My background:** Violinist for 50+ years. Viola and cello 10+ years. I have played all of them in orchestras from LaCrosse to Appleton. I also have been a church organist and pianist for 50+ years.

I have taught in the Menasha public school system in their string program for the last 8 years besides an in-home studio, and I have organized string groups in several schools including Menasha public schools and St. Peter Lutheran School. I offer a complete course from music theory to practice in all types of music from classical to modern to jazz to church music.

### **What your child can expect:**

- Weekly 20-minute private lessons during the school day
- Lesson books appropriate to their level of playing
- Twice a year recitals—once at St. Peter’s Children’s Christmas service and once in the Spring with their fellow string players
- Opportunities to play in church.
- Opportunities for summer music camp with rock music.

Instruments need to be purchased or rented. Following is a sample of prices for these instruments:

- Prices vary on rentals from \$25 to \$40 per month. On occasion, I am able to purchase used instruments for \$50 apiece and will try to keep this option going.

### **Tuition:**

\$150 for 30 lessons to be collected yearly, monthly, weekly, or however you wish to pay.

Precautions—I will use the appropriate viral cleaner on all instruments each time they are used. I will use a face mask if it is determined a necessity by the school/board of education.
