Tuition Explanation

- 922 Family Tuition:** Families who have chosen 922 Ministries — St. Peter Lutheran or The CORE — as their church home are charged the rates above as set by our 922 Leadership Team and Board of Education. These families receive a gift from the congregation for each child for tuition and also support the overall ministry of our congregation through their offering contributions.
- Friend of 922:** St. Peter Lutheran School serves families who have made other churches their home. These families are charged a “Friend of 922” tuition rate.
- Friend of 922 from area WELS Congregation:** St. Peter Lutheran School serves families who have made other area WELS churches their church home. Many area WELS churches offer tuition assistance to their church families. Families should contact their pastor or congregational leadership for tuition assistance information.

Tuition Payments

Parents have three options in paying for their child's tuition. The first option is full payment on school registration day in August. The second option is parents can make two tuition payments. The first payment is due on registration day. The second payment is due in January 2025. The third option is for parents to make monthly tuition payments. These payments are automatic withdrawals from either a checking or savings account. Parents will need to complete a registration form for this service. The first payment is made in September.

Financial Aid

922 Families are eligible and encouraged to apply for needs-based financial aid. Applications are processed using a service through FACTS. The window for financial aid applications runs from March 1 through April 31.

Wisconsin Parental Choice Program
